

Everything goes right and left if you want it: the art of Sergei Sviatchenko

Sergei Sviatchenko is an artist constantly in flux. His shape-shifting art draws on the world around him, harnessing the cultural tides with twenty-five years of image-making.

Sviatchenko speaks a unique creative language. His art sits somewhere between the known and the unimaginable – merging pop culture with politics, personal memory with collective histories, or architecture and science with the logic of dreams.

His hand has lent itself to many subject and medium: from his early work as a painter; through his crafted collages in books such as Less; his commissioned art works for international brands and institutions; and more recently to film-making, with Street & White, which was screened in London in 2006.

For the first time, 'Everything goes right and left if you want it', will present a cross-media collection of Sviatchenko's rich portfolio; revealing the unique creative vision of this truly contemporary artist.

'Everything goes right and left if you want it' responds to a growing international interest in the work of the artist. His collages have been celebrated across the board, from art and culture institutions in Scandavia, to the cutting edge style press in London and Tokyo.

This large format, experimental and tactile book will explore the nature and process of Sviatchenko's work.

It will speak to new international audience of art directors, editors and creatives and will be sold in major cultural institutions, art galleries and arts and media bookshops across the major capitals of the world.

More than a book, this conceptual publication will appeal as both monograph and collectors item with its high quality production and unique cutting edge design.
